## A Word From the CEO

In 2025, the Fenix Charity Fund implemented a comprehensive set of initiatives aimed at supporting children and families, expanding access to education and support services, strengthening healthcare systems, and promoting a culture of solidarity - continuing to unite partners, resources, and communities to achieve sustainable and meaningful impact.

### Key Results and Impact

- ✓ *410+ children* were regularly supported through day centers
- ✓ *30 children and young people* completed financial literacy training
- ✓ *36 participants* took part in the Youth Para Sports Games in Liepāja
- ✓ *13 day centers* were provided with essential-items baskets
- ✓ *2 therapeutic spaces* were established in Valmiera
- ✓ *1 medical institution* - Lithuanian University of Health Sciences Kauno Klinikos - was equipped with modern neonatal equipment
- ✓ *Dozens of lives potentially saved* through a blood donation campaign at Verslo Centras BH-92, Vilnius

### Key Areas of Activity

The foundation has helped to develop sports activities in Liepāja and implemented projects aimed at creating therapeutic spaces for children in Valmiera, Latvia.

In partnership with Maltiečiai (Maltese Order), the Fund donated 13 essential-items baskets to day centers, improving daily living conditions for children.

Together with Walleto, the Fund implemented a financial literacy program aimed at developing independence and practical life skills among young people.

The Fund also contributed to promoting a culture of blood donation in collaboration with Inreal Group and National Blood Center.

Special attention was given to long-term initiatives, including the development of a sensory center in Vilnius and ongoing support for healthcare infrastructure.

## Fenix Charity and Support Foundation

Fenix Charity and Support Foundation was established to implement social and charitable programs in Lithuania. The priority areas of the foundation's activities are as follows:

- ✓ Educational programs;
- ✓ Support for healthcare institutions;
- ✓ Support for socially vulnerable groups, including orphans and people with disabilities;
- ✓ Physical activity and youth development centers;
- ✓ Social and cultural project competitions;
- ✓ Support for crisis centers.

Fenix Charity Foundation was established in October 2023. By early December, a dedicated team of volunteers had been assembled, quickly integrating into the organization's activities and, within the same year, focusing on several ongoing projects in Lithuania and Latvia. In 2024, the foundation continued to build on this momentum, concentrating on impactful initiatives across both countries. The team was further expanded to strengthen its operations and foster new partnerships.

In 2025, the foundation focused all its efforts on Lithuania, implementing initiatives nationwide and striving to create an even greater positive impact for children and communities most in need of support.

## 1. Enhancing Infant Development Through the Use of a Dual Incubator



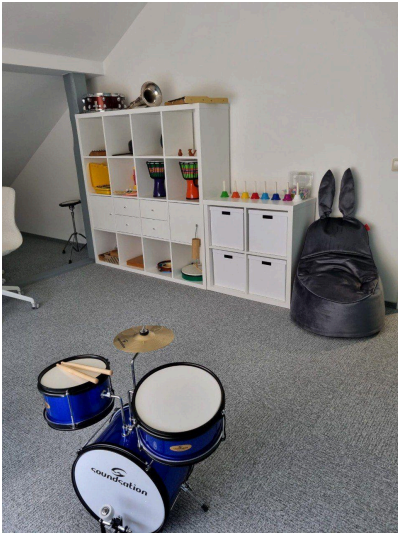
The Fenix Charity foundation raised **€38,000** to purchase a new 'Dual Incu i' incubator for the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at the Hospital of the Lithuanian University of Health Sciences Kaunas Clinics.

The incubator provides vital support for premature newborns, ensuring optimal conditions for growth, including oxygen regulation, temperature maintenance, and humidity control. This equipment helps improve infant care, development, and survival outcomes by providing stability during the very first moments of life.



The project was implemented in collaboration with UAB 'Walletto', an electronic money institution, and the Hospital of the Lithuanian University of Health Sciences Kaunas Clinics.

## 2. Establishment of a Music Therapy Room and Nature Aesthetics Studio



The Fenix Charity foundation, together with the initiative ‘Listen - Hear - Support’ („Īsiklausyk - Išgirsk - Palaikyk“), raised **€6,217** to establish a Music Therapy Room and a Nature Aesthetics Studio at the Valmiera SOS Family Support Centre in Latvia.

These spaces are designed for children growing up without parental care, as well as for children and families facing crisis situations. In the Music Therapy Room, children can take part in both individual and group therapy sessions, while the Nature Aesthetics Studio supports their emotional, creative, and sensory development.

The project was implemented in collaboration with the organizations ‘Eņģeļi Tev Blakus’ and ‘SOS Children’s Villages Latvia’.

## 3. Youth Financial Literacy Program



The Fenix Charity foundation implemented a financial literacy education project for teenagers from care centers and socially vulnerable families. The aim of the project was to equip young people with practical knowledge of money management, responsible financial decision-making, and preparation for independent living.

During the educational sessions, participants were introduced to the core principles of financial literacy, including the value of money, responsible budgeting, the use of banking services, and early career and labor market opportunities. The sessions also addressed the most common financial mistakes young people face when starting independent life.

The sessions were delivered in the form of interactive workshops, featuring discussions, practical exercises, and engaging activities that helped young people better understand financial processes and apply their knowledge in everyday life.

The project was implemented in collaboration with UAB 'Walletto', an electronic money institution, and the public organization 'Žmonės žmonėms'.

## 4. ‘Donor Day’ Blood Donation Initiative

On October 20, the Fenix Charity foundation, together with “Inreal Group” and the National Blood Center, organized the ‘Donor Day’ blood donation initiative for employees of the BH-92 Business Center in Vilnius.



Employees of ‘Walletto’ and other companies operating within the business center also joined the initiative. During the event, donors gave blood that will help ensure healthcare institutions are supplied with vital blood components and provide support to patients requiring urgent treatment.

This initiative contributed to promoting blood donation and raising public awareness, highlighting that a single act of donation can save more than one life.

The project was implemented in collaboration with “Inreal Group”, the National Blood Center, and UAB “Walletto”, an electronic money institution.

## 5. Sensory Day Center - The First of Its Kind in Lithuania



The Fenix Charity foundation contributed to the establishment of a sensory day center at the Vilnius SOS Children's Villages Day Centre. A total of **€30,000** in funding was raised to support the implementation of this project.



The day centre features four sensory spaces: a sports and stimulation room, a calming room, a learning area, and a shared living space with a dedicated zone for teenagers. These spaces help children better regulate their emotions, reduce stress, improve concentration, and develop social and sensory skills.



The Vilnius day centre can accommodate up to 25 children at a time; however, due to the continuous turnover of participants, this initiative represents a long-term investment in the well-being of many children, a safer childhood, and a brighter future.

The project was implemented in collaboration with the organization "SOS Children's Villages Lithuania".

## 6. Neonatal Support: Incubator and Respiratory Equipment for Antakalnis Hospital

The Fenix Charity foundation allocated **€53,000** in funding for the purchase of vital medical equipment for the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit of Vilnius City Clinical Hospital.



Approximately 1,800 newborns are delivered each year at Vilnius City Clinical Hospital, some of whom are born prematurely or experience respiratory complications. These infants require specialized care and advanced medical equipment to help stabilize their condition during the first moments of life.

The funds raised were used to acquire an 'Infant Warmer' resuscitation and heating unit, as well as a 'Medin NC3' non-invasive respiratory therapy system. This equipment will help ensure improved care and treatment for premature and critically ill newborns.

This project was supported by the **Fenix Charity** foundation and UAB 'Walletto', an electronic money institution, in collaboration with Vilnius City Clinical Hospital.

## 7. Creating a Better Day for Children - Together

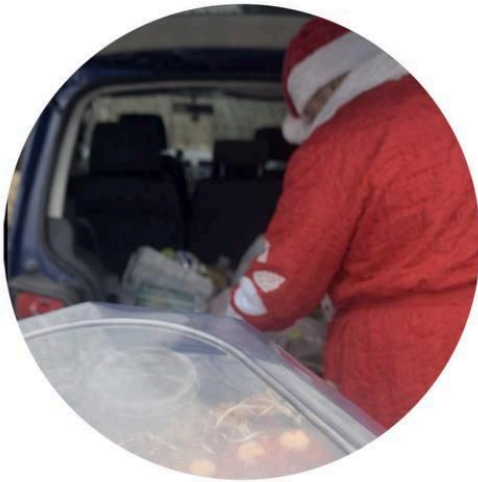


The Fenix Charity foundation raised **€1,300** in support of children attending 13 day centres established by the Order of Malta Relief Service (Maltiečiai).

As part of the project, essential supply kits were prepared, each valued at approximately €100. These kits included stationery, hygiene products, and other everyday necessities to help children prepare for school, maintain personal hygiene, have access to warm meals, and feel safe in day centres.

The project was implemented in collaboration with the Order of Malta Relief Service.

## 8. A Festive Morning Gathering



On Christmas morning, December 25, volunteers from the Fenix Charity foundation visited five care homes in Vilnius and Grigiškės. Each centre received gift baskets valued at €100, filled with fresh fruit, healthy snacks, and treats for the Christmas breakfast table, helping children feel the festive spirit from the very start of the day.



This small but thoughtful gesture helped create a warm, cozy, and joyful atmosphere, allowing children to experience the spirit of the holiday and feel cared for from the very start of the day.

The project was initiated by volunteers of the **Fenix Charity** foundation, in collaboration with the non-profit organization ‘Žmonės žmonėms’, which supported participant coordination and provided the list of children.

## 9. Become a Child's Secret Santa

The Fenix Charity foundation implemented a Christmas project for children from SOS Children's Villages day centres and the non-profit organization 'Žmonės žmonėms'. As part of the initiative, 50 letters were collected in which children shared their Christmas wishes.

Every child's wish was fulfilled: although the main gift value was up to €25, volunteers added sweets and small additional presents, creating a more personal and joyful experience for each child.

'Walletto', together with other foundation volunteers, actively participated in the implementation of the project by preparing gifts and responding to the children's letters. Each gift not only fulfilled a child's wish but also conveyed warmth and the true spirit of Christmas.
